

BRAZIL e-Visa for MINORS (children and those under 18 years of age)

There are four categories of minors seeking Brazil e-Visas:

- 1) Both parents approve the e-Visa request for the minor.
- 2) The only parent responsible for the minor approves the e-Visa request for the minor.
- 3) The only legal guardian of the minor child approves the e-Visa request for the minor.
- 4) Both legal guardians of the minor child approve the e-Visa request for the minor.

Parent(s) or Guardian(s) must provide additional documents to support the minor's application.

1) Both parents approve the Visa request for the minor.

- Photo of Parent 1
- Passport Bio of Parent 2
- Photo of Parent 2
- Authorization letter (see Consent Letter for Minors Applying for a Brazilian Visa)
- Birth Certificate showing names of parents

2) The only parent responsible for the minor approves the Visa request for the minor.

- Birth Certificate showing names of parents
- Justification Letter (This document can be death certificate, single parent custody legal document or any document which justifies as why only single parent is approving visa request.)

3) The only legal guardian approves the Visa request for the minor.

- Passport Bio of Guardian 1
- Photo of Guardian 1
- Authorization letter (see Consent Letter for Minors Applying for a Brazilian Visa)
- Birth Certificate
- Justification Letter (This document can be death certificate, single parent custody legal document or any document which justifies as why only single parent is approving visa request.)

4) Both legal guardians approve the Visa request for the minor.

- Passport Bio of Guardian 1
- Photo of Guardian 1
- Passport Bio of Guardian 2
- Photo of Guardian 2
- Authorization letter (see Consent Letter for Minors Applying for a Brazilian Visa)
- Birth Certificate
- Justification Letter (This document can be death certificate, single parent custody legal document or any document which justifies as why only single parent is approving visa request.)

All documents must be under 300 kb, and be in jpeg format.
